Tour Details and Description

Walk the Rhinegau & Middle Rhine valley

Mountain chains with legendary views onto the river Rhine, vineyards as far as the eye can reach, countless castels and palaces, enchanting half-timber: all of this and more will you discover during the hiking week located between Mainz and Coblenz. The Rheingau-region with its idyllic wine locations and numerous wine taverns called 'Straußenwirtschaften' invite you to sample the delicious Riesling-wine. In the UNESCO-World Cultural Heritage region of the 'Mittelrheingau' you walk past a number of majestic strongholds situated on ledges along the tracks of pure Rhine romanticism, which already inspired Heinrich Heine to create his Loreley-song. Incredible scenic beauty and culture – it is not for nothing that the Rheinsteig-path was nominated Germany's most beautiful hiking route. Simply hiking 'on a high level, in the truest sense of the word!

Character - Mountain hiking Level 3

Wine-grower paths, solitary walking paths and old bridle paths ensure varied walking. Basic fitness and sure-footedness is required for uphill/downhill sections on the mountain ridges of Middle-Rhine valley. Walking times of up to 6 hrs. And distances of up to 24 km are to be reckoned.

Itinerary

Day 1

Individual journey to Rüdesheim

Day 2

Rüdesheim - Lorch Climb the high rides of Middle-Rhine valley (by cable car) and enjoy the beautiful views on the estuary of Nahe. Wine-grower communities Assmannshausen and Lorch display many half-timbered houses. Walking time: approx. 5.5 hrs. Details: approx. 21,3 km, +660 m / -680 m

Day 3

Lorch - Dörscheid/Kaub The mountain ranges offer



beautiful views across Rhine valley. Little wine-grower towns Kaub or Dörscheid will grant for a pleasant evening. Walking time: approx. 4.5 hrs. Details: approx. 13,6 km, +460 m / -460 m

Day 4

Dörscheid/Kaub – St. Goarshausen/surroundings Climb on legendary Loreley-rock and look down on river Rhine. Three fortresses in St. Goarshausen are expecting you. Walking time: approx. 6 hrs. Details: approx. 19,2 km, +590m / -620 m

Day 5

St. Goarshausen/surroundings – Kamp Bornhofen Walk on idyllic paths to wine-grower communities on the river Rhine. Fortress Liebenstein and fortress Sterrenberg are two "hostile brothers" from the 12th/13th century. Walking time: approx. 6 hrs. Details: approx. 21,3 km, +690 m / -700 m

Day 6

Kamp Bornhofen – Braubach Fortress Liebeneck, Dinkelholder mills and a completely conserved Marksburg fortress are your faithful companions on the stage to Braubach, a wine-grower town with fortification wall and many half-timbered houses. Walking time: approx. 5,5 hrs. Details: approx. 17,5 km, +620 m / -620 m Hotel (example): Zum Weissen Schwanen

Day 7

Braubach – Koblenz Cross a tributary river to Rhine at Lahnstein and ascent to Westerwald. One final highlight is Ruppertsklamm – a dramatic gorge and then the grand final: the Deutsches Eck (German Corner) in Koblenz where river Moselle joins the waters of Rhine. Walking time: approx. 5.5 hrs. Details: approx. 20,1 km, +690 m / - 680 m Hotel
