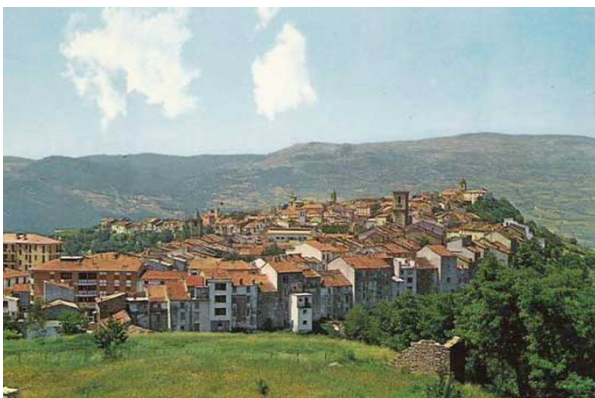

Tour Details and Description

Agnone is famous for – - the bell foundry working here since 1040 AD! It's the oldest surviving family business in the western world. A medieval town, off the beaten track, a community eager to share long standing traditions – gastronomic, cultural and artistic.

Not just a language school, it is an experience!

Discover family run businesses producing excellent cheeses, salamis, olive oil, honey, wine and other regional specialities. Here there is little tourism so the Agnonese are keen to engage with visitors; to cook and to share traditions and history of their town in Alto-Molise, in the Provincia di Isernia, between Abruzzo and Puglia. 850 m above sea level, Agnone in the summer stays fresh and cool, the local population is around 2000. The summer months are very festive with Italian visitors and families returning from the cities.

THE ITINERARY IS JUST A GUIDE OF WHAT TO EXPECT IN A 2 WEEK PROGRAM

The program has been specifically designed to get you learning in the classroom, , , outside of it. Practise by immersing yourself in the lives of the local community, discovering their history and traditions, and cooking and sharing meals.

Take a look at our sample programme for a guide to what to expect, but remember, no two weeks are the same; activities and encounters vary depending on local events, festivals and the seasons.

Transform hard won knowledge of Italian into fluent expression and every day colloquialisms. Revise and refresh what you already know - and . We study grammar, of course, but teaching you loads of new rules is our focus - it's on getting you to put into practise what you but are maybe not so sure of.

Your accommodation:

All rooms have private bathrooms and are centrally located, within walking distance to activities. Breakfast is offered onsite, and guests are welcome to use the kitchen for light snacks and simple lunches.

In addition to daily breakfast, 11 other main meals are included. On weekdays you will generally be left to your own devices to prepare something simple for lunch in your B&B or at a local eatery.

Handwashing facilities are available. There is no launderette in the town, but we offer a laundry service on request.

Included in the Italian Language School Program:

- 30 hrs Italian instruction with qualified native language teachers, plus interaction with them throughout your visit
- Transport between central Rome and Agnone (see Travel Pack below for full details)
- Daily visits and encounters conducted in Italian with local artisans & personalities
- Cooking and sharing meals in private homes with hosts
- Weekend activities and conversations
- Visits to other towns in the region
- Sites of historical interest and traditional festivals are explored
- Entrance tickets, guides, and hosts
- Daily Bed and Breakfast in private room and bathroom
- 11 additional meals, either lunch or dinner

Itinerary

Day 1

Sunday arrival at Rome Fiumicino, transfer to Agnone
- settle in to accommodation - welcome drink and dinner

Day 2

Morning, after breakfast. An orientation/visit of the town and centro storico. Meet the teachers for your assessment in the early afternoon, then after a walk we lunch at an Agriturismo outside Agnone. In the late afternoon there will be a film screening evening.

Day 3

Free time in the morning before your first Italian lesson with break 10.00 – 13.15. Free time for lunch, study and homework. In the late afternoon we take a tour of the town's family run food shops, followed by an evening dinner in Agnone

Day 4

Morning Italian lesson with break 10.00 – 13.15 followed by free time for lunch, study, and homework until late afternoon. Conversation classes are available with teachers evening and a visit to a local town and dinner

Day 5

Morning Italian lesson with break 10.00 – 13.15, free time for lunch, study and homework until late afternoon when we visit the Marinelli bell foundry. An evening dinner in Agnone followed by a film

Day 6

Morning Italian lesson with break 10.00 – 13.15, free time for lunch, study and homework until late afternoon. Conversation classes are available with teachers then an evening of cooking and eating

dinner with local hosts

Day 7

Morning Italian lesson with break 10.00 – 13.15, free time for lunch, study and homework until late afternoon. today we take a trip to Pescopennataro sculptor's studio before and evening dinner in a countryside agriturismo

Day 8

In the morning we hike from Capracotta to Agnone with an Italian guide. In the late morning we find the market and cook lunch with our Italian hosts. In the late afternoon, there are conversation groups with a free evening for dinner

Day 9

A morning visit and talk about the Samnite ruins (or other site) followed by a late lunch. An event outside Agnone in the early evening, a film screening evening and your free time.

Day 10

Morning Italian lesson with break 10.00 – 13.15, free time for lunch, study and homework until late afternoon. Then we visit Azienda producing honey, olive oil, wine and an evening dinner at Azienda with home grown produce.

Day 11

Morning Italian lesson with break 10.00 – 13.15, free time for lunch, study and homework until late afternoon. Conversation available with teachers then an evening dinner in Agnone .

Day 12

Morning Italian lesson with break 10.00 – 13.15, free time for lunch, study and homework until late afternoon. A visit to a copper foundry, workshop and museum and an evening dinner outside Agnone

Day 13

Early morning (optional) is a visit to cheese caseificio then your morning Italian lesson with break 10.00 – 13.15, free time for lunch, study and homework until late afternoon. Afterwards experience cooking with local hosts and an evening dinner in Agnone with local hosts.

Day 14

Morning Italian lesson with break 10.00 – 13.15, free time for lunch, stud and homework until late afternoon. Then we get together for a talk/discussion on the transumanza evening. Your final dinner in Agnone

Day 15

Departure with transfer to Rome Fiumicino Airport
